The Richard Pate School

The Richard Pate School, founded in 1946, forms part of the Pate's Grammar School Foundation, a charity dating from 1574.

In 1987, the school was relocated to an excellent eleven and a half acre semi-rural site on the southern outskirts of Cheltenham. Improved facilities since relocation include an all-weather surface for games, a new music school, computer suite, library, science lab, language room, art room, conservation area for environmental studies and an adventure play area.

All national curriculum foundation subjects are taught with good SEN provision for both the under-achiever and the gifted and talented child. A plethora of extra-curricular activities operate during lunch break and after normal school.

Children are thoroughly prepared for both grammar and independent school entry at 11+ with leavers typically going to thirteen or fourteen different senior schools for Year 7.

The Appointment

The successful applicant will work alongside a second Deputy Head and will be directly responsible to the Headmaster and the school's Trustees. The Deputy Heads also sit on the Senior Management Team which includes the Head of the Prep Department, the Assistant Head of the Prep Department and the Senior Mistress.
