COVID

- Whilst social distancing and wearing face coverings is now optional, we would ask that you
 respect the wishes of those parents who continue to observe these guidelines and also

 pick up.
- We will still ask visitors to wear face masks and hand sanitise when coming into the building.
- Please do not send your child to School if they or anyone in your household has symptoms or a positive COVID test and notify the School immediately.

Remote Learning and Showbie

 The School will continue to use Showbie for remote learning if a child is unable to attend School due to Government regulations and is well enough to learn. In addition, it may also be used for homework assignments.

Uniform

- Summer or winter uniform can be worn until half term after half term only winter uniform.
- We will be maintaining the increased ventilation, in line with the guidance, which may make school buildings cooler than usual. Please make sure your children are appropriately dressed with additional layers and a coat in school every day.

PREP (Reception, Year I and Year 2)

Children will wear:

- Normal uniform to School on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; and
- Games kit on Tuesday and Thursday.
- (Year I and 2 may choose to do Modern Dance on a Wednesday and more information will be sent about what they will need to bring.)

JUNIORS (Years 3-6)

- Children are to wear games kit on the days that they have PE or Games lessons and normal uniform on the other days. See table below.
- Some children may be required to change at School if they have an optional club or activity on a day when they are wearing normal uniform (these are noted in Green italics).
- After half term we hope to revert back to the children bringing their games kit in on a Monday and changing where necessary for lessons/clubs.
